The scientific project

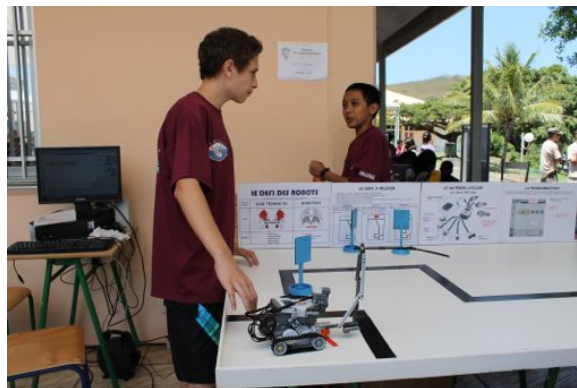
The group of students must present a scientific project, that is to say, a visual (and / or sound) with a scientific-displays, models, cd-rom, video, web pages, slide show (or photo album) , experiments, plays, parades, ... that can be live commentary during the day by one (or more) student (s). We insist on the fact that the students project must be interactive and not just be a poster.

The contest will run all day for the public to come and listen to all or any présentations while circulating along the students stands.

The contest will be held at Jules Garnier High School the Saturday 13th of october Saturday.

Students should practice answering questions in a variety of ways. A special presentation will be made during the day to members of the scientific jury, which implies a reasonable mastery of the scientific concepts used.



The jury

There will be two catégories : one for the middle scholls (years 7 to 9) and one for the senior high schools (years 10 to 12). International participants will participate in the senior high school level

- A public vote will take place throughout the day, based on visitors évaluation,
- A vote will be conducted by a scientific panel of teachers, researchers, education and government members.

The organization of the voting will be provided by SYMBIOSE association.

Results will be given later in the day with awards at 4pm.
